Material Transport Survey Overview

Introduction

This survey provides a thorough analysis of your hospital's material transport current methods and then utilizes the information for project planning/budgeting.

1. Hospital department personnel participate by recording material transport routine and non-routine deliveries. All shifts participate
2. The data collection process is conducted for 3 consecutive days across a typical representative time frame.
3. During the data collection process time frame parallel interviews are conducted with the participating staff to determine data accuracy, typical problems encountered with current material transport methods, as well as input and suggestions on potential solutions.
4. Delivery route distances are measured and wait times at elevator banks are recorded.
5. MTM Industry Standards & Research Association are factored into the results to account for expected delays and fatigue factors.
6. Full Time Equivalents (FTE's) are not solely identified staff reduction consideration but are presented as potential for professional staff labor recapture.
7. A comprehensive report is prepared including:
 - Analysis of current hospital methods and associated inefficiencies.

- Examination and analysis of items being transported revealing relevancy, sensitivity, urgency, etc.

- A department by department report is presented as well as a thorough examination of interrelationship and impact of the total interconnected system,.

- A budget estimate and presentation of benefits to be realized.
