Data-driven software enabling real-time analysis, optimisation & forecasting

The Customer

Situated in South Australia's acclaimed Barossa Valley wine region, Treasury Wine Estates' (TWE) Bilyara Packaging Centre is one of the largest and most advanced facilities of its type in the industry. It handles millions of cases per year of premium wine for local and international distribution.

In 2005, TWE directly linked production to their high-bay facility, featuring 22,000 double-deep pallet locations, serviced by nine Vectura ASRS cranes, capable of a throughput of more than 500 pallets every hour. Additionally, the solution included a pallet conveyor system with automatic despatch staging lanes.

"The automation in place created significant cost savings as we were able to consolidate storage facilities whilst increasing density. The fully integrated system has improved safety, reduced overall operational costs, and eliminated the need for forklifts. The onsite team maintains a smooth and consistent operation whilst enabling instant response times," said Mark Baldock, Warehouse Manager at TWE.



The Challenge




